<u>Tips for participating in online (Zoom) worship</u> (click this link for simple instructions for using Zoom with a computer or a phone or ipad, https://cc-eh.org/events/zoom/)

- When joining the service, you will see a message that you are in a waiting room
 - o Do not close the window
 - o Wait and the host will let you in
- Have your real name showing
 - Your name can be changed in your account settings
 - O You can type in your name before entering the meeting
 - You can update your name once you are in the meeting
- Keep your microphone on mute unless sharing joys/concerns or participating in a unison reading/prayer
 - o Participants with children should unmute during the children's' message
 - It is especially important to remain muted during songs
- Use the "raise hand" function if you would like to share and cannot unmute
 - o The host will be able to unmute you
 - o You can "raise" and "lower" your hand anytime
 - o You can also send a chat message to the host if you prefer
